- Create daily learning strategies for vocabulary enhancement and test strategies.
- Lead SAT and ACT prep workshops using Princeton Review guides and other web-based programs.
- Work directly with students supporting their visions of college and friendship.

- Team player who can also work effectively on their own to accomplish tasks.
- Desire to work with a non-profit and youth.
- Dependable, consistent and a strong sense of commitment.
- Experience preparing youth for college or current college students.

- Deliver curriculum and workshops after school programs run from 2:30-4:30pm or 3-6pm Monday – Thursday or during no-school days.
