#### ***Responsibilities:***

- Assist Dreamers in completing homework, studying for a test or strengthening academic skills
- Work one-on-one or in small groups
- Help Dreamers understand issues, theories and application

#### ***Qualifications:***

- Dependable, consistent and a strong sense of commitment
- Desire to work with youth
- Open to constructive feedback and tutoring tips
- Flexible

#### ***Time Commitment and Worksites:***

- Tutors work with Dreamers during the after-school program
- After school programs approximately run from 2:30pm-6pm, Monday – Thursday
- School term commitment to tutor at least once a week
- Number of hours per week is flexible
- Forest Grove or NE Portland
